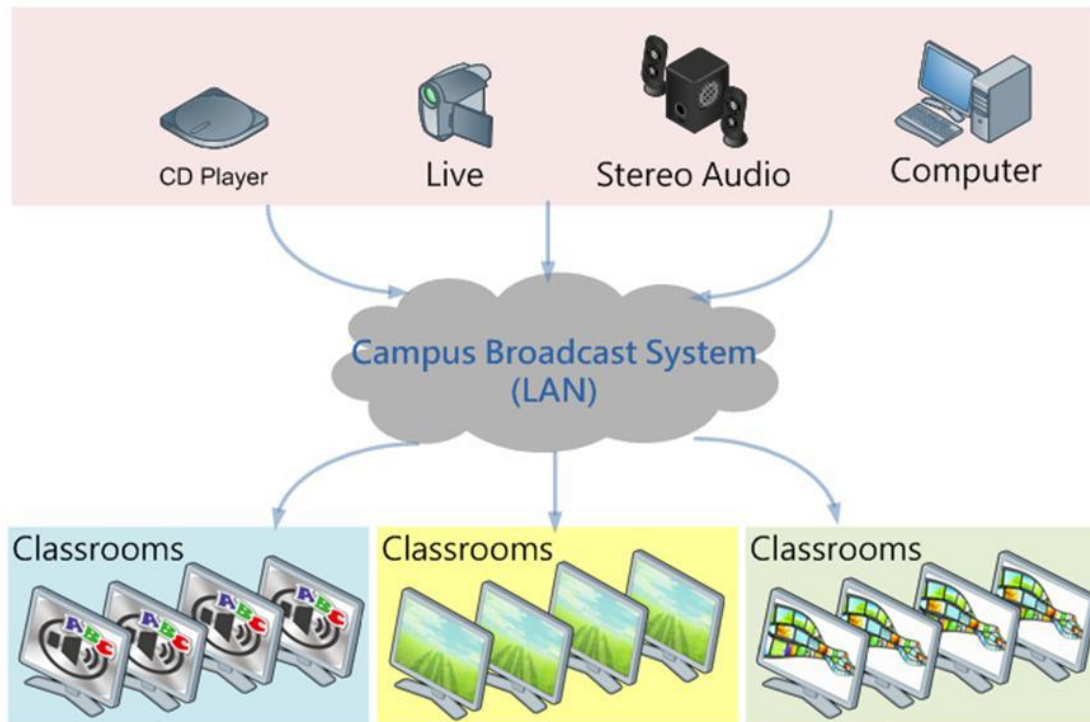


KVM over IP

Introduction

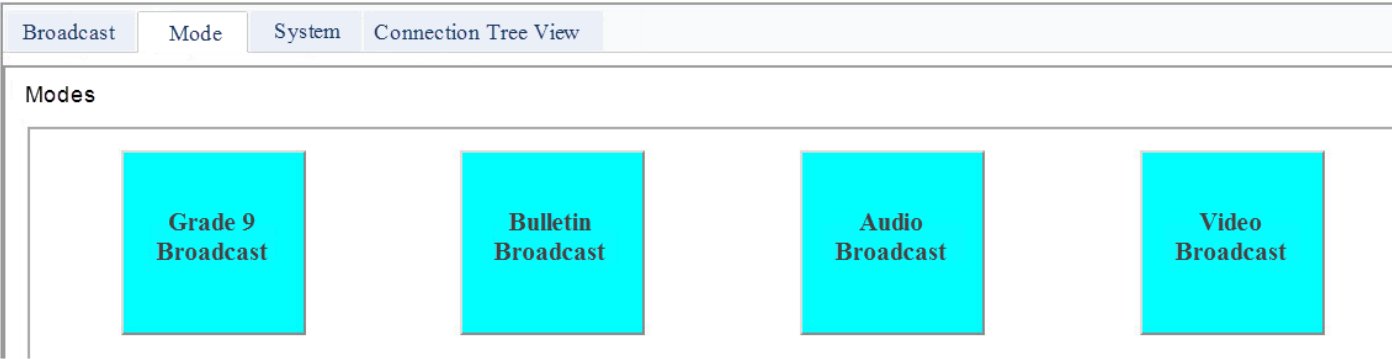
The Connection Manager Plus is a Windows based software providing Tx/Rx Matrix connections for school campus application with the following features.

Group Management

You can group all of Rx with Class-name by the Group Management so that it will be easier for sending video/audio contents according to Class level.

Mode (Macro) Management

Provides Mode feature to define a Macro which contains One Tx + Multiple Rx + Action. This is to provide a convenient and easier operation for school application. The Action can be [Broadcast] or [Stop Broadcast], ... etc.



Schedule Management

The software provides Schedule management with One-time, Daily, and Weekly for the school routine jobs. For example, you can define a schedule activity to start broadcasting English learning Textbook to all classrooms according to grades on 8:00 AM Mon ~ Fri weekly.
